# QUALCOMM AND XiMED MEDICAL GROUP COLLABORATE IN WIRELESS HEALTH

SAN DIEGO - December 7, 2011- Qualcomm Life, a wholly owned subsidiary of Qualcomm Incorporated (NASDAQ:QCOM) and XiMED Medical Group are proud to announce a new collaborative relationship aimed at bringing wireless health technology to the marketplace. XiMED will be the only medical group out of 31 companies chosen by Qualcomm to participate in this project and will be used as a beta site for multiple applications of wireless healthcare technology. In August, XiMED also announced the formation of a new collaborative relationship with Scripps Mercy Physician Partners. The new group, known as Integrated Physicians Medical Group (IPMG) will have a combined membership of over 1000 physicians.

“Qualcomm Life’s mission is to make wireless health simple for medical device manufacturers, and to ultimately have an impact on improving health care,” said Rick Valencia, Vice President and General Manager of Qualcomm Life. The value of wireless technology is clearly seen in improving the transfer of information from patient to provider. In selecting a health care partner, Valencia said “We chose XiMED due to the quality of their physicians and their reputation for excellence in the San Diego area”. The first devices to be tested will be focused on home healthcare applications that will provide monitoring of a patient’s health and, in the event of a problem, patient information will get quickly relayed to a physician. Urgent and critical needs will be attended to, eliminating the normal delay experienced in today’s crowded healthcare venues.

XiMED physicians will assist in protocol development and be involved in determining patient selection for the in-home wireless devices. “We are excited about our new partnership with Qualcomm” said Tom Sounhein, CEO, XiMED Medical Group. “The use of wireless technology has the potential to dramatically improve patient care. We are turning a page on the way health care will be delivered in the future”.
